As a manufacturer of recyclable packaging, it has been at the very heart of our business philosophy throughout this time to always consider how our activities impact on the environment.



  - We will utilise the full potential of our workforce by providing necessary training and a working environment that reduces our carbon footprint.
- **Products**
  - We will ensure that we use the thinnest possible material gauges without reducing quality levels
  - We will continue to promote the recyclability of our products.
  - We will work with our suppliers to ensure that our materials are produced in the most effective manner to minimize environmental impact.
- **Waste**
  - We will optimize our packaging design to minimize packaging waste.
  - We will sort our metal scrap as necessary to ensure its recyclability.
